If you're J.D. Whittenburg, the answer is easy.: shake things up a bit with an indie pop/rock CD inspired by a love for The Kinks, The Who, The Beatles and Bruce Springsteen.

Whittenburg, as both protagonist and antagonist, brings into focus a series of 12 storied ex-votos whose best moments evoke intimate conversations about defeat, love, desire, and longing. From the selfishly shrewd "Keep Me Honest" and the joyful memory of "I Miss Your Face" to the moody daydreams of "Gospel Music" and "Just Another Saturday," J. D. Whittenburg's songwriting never over-romanticizes nor does it rely heavily on metaphor. J.D. effortlessly tackles the complications of being human in straightforward, deliciously impolite interpretations made only more personal by his warm, whiskey-tinged voice.
