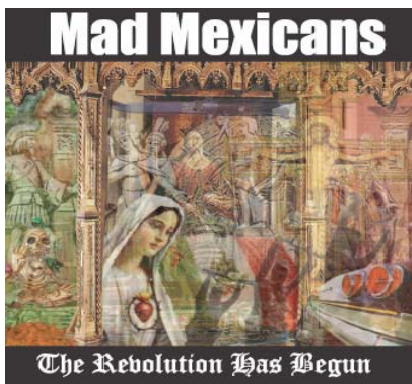


Mad Mexicans
